# ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Bucks Recycling Ltd is committed to minimising the environmental impact of the company's activities via continuous, measurable improvement in environmental performance and will seek to develop an ethos of environmental responsibility in all its employees.

The director, Tricia Murray, recognises that the collection, transfer, segregation and recycling of waste are the core activities of the company and this provides numerous opportunities to protect the environment.

In 2019 Bucks Recycling achieved the following objectives:

1. Achieved ISO 14001 accreditation to improve environmental compliance and to improve environmental performance. (March 2019)
2. Achieved 98% diversion from landfill (by weight).

Our objectives for 2020 are:

1. To divert 100% of all waste processed in our WTS from landfill
2. To reduce dust by constant monitoring and use of dust suppression in all areas inside Hangar 5 and on the surrounding roads and by all lorries going through the wheel wash before driving on to the main exit road
3. Achieve FORS silver

In addition to these objectives, the TCM will carry out a daily site inspection to monitor emissions and ensure the waste operations KPIs are being achieved. The HSEQ Manager will carry out a more in- depth inspection once a month. The Environment Agency audit on a regular unannounced basis and the results of these audits are kept on a public register.
